Greeter:

A vital position in children's ministry! Assist children and parents in registering and/or signing in on our Check-in system. Answer questions and direct families to the correct locations. Help monitor children's ministry areas for safety and support, as well as conduct headcounts to ensure that all children are accounted for. This position requires a once-a-month commitment.

Preschool Teacher:

Lead and guide the preschool children (ages 2-4) in their Sunday school lessons. This includes telling a story, running a craft, and playing with the kids. All materials and lessons are included. This position has a month-on and month-off schedule.

Preschool Junior Leader:

For students in grades 6 through 9. Assist the preschool teacher with the Sunday school class. Play with the children, support them in making crafts, and assist the instructor with anything they need.

Elementary Small Group Leader:

In our kindergarten to Grade 5 program, you will be able to connect with a consistent group of children. You will guide the kids through the activities provided after our large group story. This position is available on a month-on and month-off basis.

Elementary Storyteller:

Communicate our weekly Bible story and its relevance to children in an interesting and enjoyable manner that the kids will grasp. Scripts and props are provided, and the story is expected to be told with few notes. This is a monthly commitment.
