Role:

Commitments:

- Along with mentor, create a meeting schedule and discuss realistic goals and expectations
- Meet with your mentor once a month (at minimum) for 1–2 hours and attend encouragement gatherings.
- Come prepared and willing to engage meaningfully in each meeting.
- Maintain open, honest communication about progress and challenges.

It draws you closer to Jesus as you reflect on where He is at work in your life and context and receive guidance, encouragement, and spiritual support.
